First dog on the line 12:00 pm

Jumping Rd 1 (J1 level) - qualifier

Jumping Rd 2 (J3 level) - qualifier

Agility Rd 1 (A2/A3 level) - qualifier

Agility Rd 2 (A2/A3 level) – FINAL. Must be entered to run. See eligibility for placements, ribbons and awards below.

- Jump height: AKC official heights (Regular and Preferred)
- FEO and Fix and Go On will be allowed, following AKC definitions.
- Bitches in season will be allowed and must start on a mat provided by handler or wear panties, at owner's choice and risk
- Scoring: faults, then time. Each refusal or fault is 5 penalty points. Eliminations: off course; 3 refusals; handler going over or thru equipment; handler or dog disturbing equipment in such a way that dog cannot negotiate it anymore; starting before judge signals; handler purposefully touching dog or equipment, dog fouling the ring.
- Time faults: SCT will be fastest clean run +15%. If no clean runs, fastest run with fewest faults + 15%.
- Final: all dogs entered in Agility Rd 2 will be able to run in this class, but only qualified dogs, those not eliminated in at least one of the previous 3 classes will be eligible for placements, ribbons and prizes. Dogs jumping in preferred will compete at their preferred jump height against dogs of similar size in the regular height. E.g: 16" P and 20" regular results will be combined for awards in finals. If there are fewer than 3 dogs in the final of any jump height, they will be combined with other jump heights in categories as follows: Small dogs (4P-8P and 8-12" regular); Medium dogs (12P and 16" regular); Large dogs (16P-20P and 20-24" regular)
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in final for each jump height or category as described above.
- Covid precautions will follow local mandates and CSZ rules. These will be published with confirmation letter.
- CSZ hold harmless agreement must be signed prior to check in for first class.
